THE PSYCHIATRIST

Psychiatric emergencies (0498.98.23.23)

Orientation towards outside services

Examination of colleagues to be reintegrated into service after a period of invalidity

Support to Heads of Units and Human Resources Managers

THE PSYCHOLOGISTS

Personal problems (anxiety, depression, solitude, expatriations, family problems etc.)

Professional problems (stress, conflictual situations, harassment, motivational problems etc.)

THE SOCIAL WORKERS

Interpersonal problems (family, couple, children etc.)

Financial problems

Adaptation to host country or new working environment

Information on administrative procedures in the context of social issues
